

Things to note:

- The examples provided here are intended as illustrative and educational purposes only and should not be used as a guide for your anaesthetic fees
- These examples are based on a Relative Value Guide value of \$58 and assume a patient without other medical issues, between the age of 4 and 75 undergoing non-urgent surgery.
- For funds marked with a \*, if the gap is greater than \$500, the health fund will reduce their rebates to the “Health fund Minimum” and your gap will be higher (not applicable to LaTrobe). Your anaesthetist may cap your gap at \$500
- NIB has two schemes – your rebate will depend on which scheme your anaesthetist is registered for.
